VA Butler Healthcare is continually improving existing structures, facilities, and technolgies for our Veterans. Read about our construction initiatives below - and check out our completed construction projects, the new Community Living Center (CLC) and new Domiciliary.

Health Care Center

On December 31, 2014, the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) awarded a lease contract for a 168,000 net usable square foot Health Care Center (HCC) in Butler, Pennsylvania, to Cambridge Healthcare Solutions PA, LP (Cambridge), of Vienna, Virginia. The HCC will expand VA Butler Healthcare's outpatient services to meet increasing Veteran demand and will include Primary Care, Specialty Care, Dental, Lab, Pathology, Radiology, Mental Health, and Ancillary and Diagnostic services.

The HCC will be a two-story (168,000 net usable square foot) building located on North Duffy Road, approximately 1.4 miles away from the Butler campus. Construction completion is anticipated to be 31 months from the award of the contract. During the design and construction of the new HCC, Veterans will continue to receive services without interruption either at the current main facility or one of our five Community Based Outpatient Clinics.

VA Domiciliaries have evolved from a "Soldiers' Home" to become an active clinical rehabilitation and treatment program for male and female Veterans and domiciliary programs are is now integrated with the Mental Health Residential Rehabilitation and Treatment Programs (MH RRTPs).
