Cambridge Property Group Picks Up The Harrison Building in Tysons Corner

TIAA-CREF Sells 101,000-SF Mid-Rise

Cambridge Property Group, a Vienna, VA-based real estate firm, acquired the five-story Harrison Building in McLean, VA from TIAA-CREF for an undisclosed amount.

The building delivered in 1999 at 1760 Old Meadow Rd. in the Tysons Corner submarket. It totals 101,440 square feet and will be vacant in Q1 2016, according to CoStar information. After the purchase of the property, Cambridge retitled the building as Cambridge Metro Overlook.
